The Adaptive leader's Tool Box

You've decided to work on an issue by bringing people together. Congratulations! You are on your way to better outcome through relationships. Making the decision is not enough. The people you want and need to work with may be reluctant to engage. They continuously take in messages about your sincerity and how you view them as partners. In this session, we will explore three stakeholder developed tools to help you focus on the human side of practice change. *This session is offered as a follow-up to *Leading by Convening: The Human Side of Practice Change* but participation in the prior session is not required.

Option 2: Transition Planning: Meeting the Mandate and Beyond Facilitated by Sue Sawyer

Are you overwhelmed by all the changes that are impacting transition for your students with IEPs? This interactive, hands-on workshop will explore IDEA mandates for IEPs, recent legislation and regulations that impact transition, person centered planning, the high school diploma and the course of study, assessment strategies, transition services, and collaboration.

Option 3: Best Practices to Achieve Employment (benefits planning, certifications, job-finding options) Facilitated by Linda O'Neal and Richard L. Rosenberg

This workshop will share best practices in providing career pathway work-based learning opportunities for all youth with mild, moderate and significant disabilities. Individualized job development strategies for paid and unpaid work experiences as well a direct hires will be discussed.

Supplemental Security Income (SSI) and Work Incentives Planning & Management tools will be shared to address employment benefits questions for students receiving SSI.

Additionally, graduation outcomes will be examined including: diplomas, certificates of completion and career relevant certifications.
