Transition Planning: The Basics

This training is a two - three hour workshop that provides an overview of the current legislation and research-based best practices as outlined in the publication: ***Transition Planning: The Basics*** Fall 2015.

This training is a six hour workshop that is an in-depth training based on the ***Transition Planning: The Basics***. It allows the attendees to explore information and resources in greater depth through web-based reviews and/or hands-on review of the essential aspects of the secondary transition process

Completers of this training can elect to provide training locally, regionally, or statewide in an independent contractor role.
